He is not a man because no man can create or make another man. He is not an animal, nor he is a plant. He is neither an idol nor is He a statue of any kind because none of those things can make itself or create anything else. The **maker** of anything must be different from and greater than things which he **makes**. There are various ways to know God “ALLAH” and there are many things to tell about Him. The great wonders and impressive marvels of the world are like open books in which we can read about God. Besides, God Himself comes to our aid through many Messengers and revelations He has sent down to man. Those Messengers and revelations tell us everything we need to know about God.

Note:

Most of the verses of the Bible were quoted from King James Version.

The purpose of life

What is the purpose of creation?

Creations were created by the Creator to worship Him alone with no partner.

❖ **In Psalms 95:6** (O come, let us **worship** and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD **our Maker**).

❖ **Deuteronomy 6:13** (Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God, and **serve** Him, and shalt **swear** by His name).

People ought to worship the creator not the creature

❖ **Romans 1:25** (**Who changed** the truth of God into a **lie**, and **worshipped** and **served** the **creature more than the Creator**, who is blessed for ever. Amen).

❖ **Matthew 4:10** (Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for **it is written**, Thou shalt **worship the Lord thy God**, and him only shalt thou serve).

❖ **In Luke 4:8** (And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt **worship** the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve).

Even angels worship God

❖ **Revelation 7:11** (And all the **angels** were standing round about the throne, and `about` the elders and the four living creatures; and **they fell before the throne on their faces**, and **worshipped God**).

What should I do to enter the kingdom of heaven?

❖ **Matthew 7:21** (Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but **he that doeth the will of my Father** which is in heaven).

❖ **Matthew 12:50** (For whosoever shall **do the will of my Father** which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother).

God is not a man or a son of man.

❖ **Numbers 23:19** (**God is not a man, that he should lie**; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?)

So, why do Christians call Jesus is God while he does not say that explicitly.

Jesus never says “I am God” explicitly. But he said he was “ **a man** or the **son of man**” explicitly more than 80 times in the Bible such as in:

❖ **John 8:40** (But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.)

Attributes of God:

God can't be seen in this life. Jesus was seen.

God alone never dies. Jesus was died on the cross according to Christians perspective. So, Jesus is not God.

- ❖ **Exodus 33:20** (And he said, Thou canst **not see my face**: for there shall **no man see me, and live**.)
- ❖ **John 5:37** (And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have **neither heard his voice** at any time, **nor seen his shape**).
- ❖ **Timothy 1:17** (Now unto the King **eternal, immortal, invisible**, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen).
- ❖ **Timothy 6:16** (Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom **no man hath seen, nor can see**: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen).

God is all knowing. He knows everything.

Jesus doesn't know the Hour (the day of judgment). So, he is not God.

- ❖ **Matthew 24:36** (But of that **day** and **hour** knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, **but** my Father only).

God is all powerful. Jesus is not all powerful.

Because the power with Jesus was given to him.

- ❖ **Matthew 28:18** (And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth)

Focus on the word “Also” in the following verse:

❖ **John 14:1** (Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe **also** in me.)

1). Jesus is not God. Because the word **“also”**

indicates the distinction between Jesus and God.

2). Jesus is not God. Because Jesus used to pray to God. So, they are separate. They are unequal. How come had one to pray to the other.

Judgement according to deeds

Everyone will be judged according to his/her own deeds.

- ❖ **Ezekiel 18:30** (Therefore **I will judge** you, O house of Israel, every one, saith the Lord GOD. **Repent**, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so, iniquity shall not be your ruin.)

Everyone will be responsible about himself.

- ❖ **Ezekiel 18:20** (The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: **the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him**, and the **wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him**).
- ❖ **Deuteronomy 24:16** (The fathers shall not be put to death for the children, neither shall the children be put to death for the fathers: **every man shall be put to death for his own sin**).
- ❖ **Jeremiah 31:30** (But every one shall die for his own iniquity).

Based on the previous verses, people do not bear Adam's sin.

The truth of Jesus

He was sent by God as other messengers. So, he is a messenger.

- ❖ **John 12:44** (Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.)
- ❖ **John 12:49** (For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak).
- ❖ **John 14:24** (He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me).
- ❖ **John 5:30** (I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me).
- ❖ **John 6:38** (For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of Him that sent me).
- ❖ **John 7:16** (Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me).
- ❖ **Timothy 2:5** (For there is **one God**, and one **mediator** between God and men, the man **Christ Jesus**.)

Jesus has prophecy

- ❖ **John 14:24** (He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and **the word** which ye hear is **not mine, but the Father's** which sent me).
- ❖ **John 12:49** (For I have **not spoken of myself**; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak).
- ❖ **John 12:50** (And I know that His commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even **as the Father said unto me, so I speak**).

Jesus is a prophet

- ❖ **John 9:10** (Therefore said they unto him, How were thine eyes opened?)
- ❖ **John 9:11** (He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight).
- ❖ **John 9:17** (They say unto the blind man again, What sayest thou of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? **He said, He is a prophet**).
- ❖ **John 6:14** (Then those men, when they had seen the **miracle** that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that **prophet** that should come into the world.)
- ❖ **Matthew 21:11** (And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee.)
- ❖ **Matthew 21:46** (They wanted to arrest him, but they were afraid to try because the crowds considered Jesus to be a prophet.)
- ❖ **Luke 24:19** (And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a **prophet** mighty in deed and word before God and all the people.)

No need for crucifixion

So, what do we need?

- ❖ **Ezekiel 18:21** (But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and **keep all my statutes, and do** that which is **lawful** and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.)
- ❖ **John 14:15** (If ye love me, **keep my commandments**).
- ❖ **Mark 12:29** (And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; **The Lord our God is one Lord**).
- ❖ **Mark 12:30** (And thou shalt **love the Lord thy God** with all thy **heart**, and with all thy **soul**, and with all thy **mind**, and with all thy **strength**: this is the first commandment.)
- ❖ **Matthew 22:36** (Master, which is the great commandment in the law?)

Matthew 22:37 (Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt **love the Lord thy God** with all thy **heart**, and with all thy **soul**, and with all thy **mind**.)

Matthew 22:38 (This is the first and great commandment.)

- ❖ **Luke 18:20** (Thou knowest the commandments, **Do not** commit adultery, **Do not** kill, **Do not** steal, **Do not** bear false witness, **Honour** thy father and thy mother.)

Jesus came to call sinners to repent.

- ❖ **Matthew 9:13** (But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not **come** to call the righteous, but **sinners to repentance**)

Jesus is a man. He is a servant of God like Muhammed and Moses.

Act 3:13 (The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus.)

Prophecy is delivered to prophets

- ❖ **Corinthians1 12:8** For to one is given by the Spirit⁽¹⁾ the word of wisdom⁽²⁾; **to another** the word of knowledge⁽³⁾ by the same Spirit⁽⁴⁾
- ❖ **Corinthians1 12:9** **To another** faith by the **same Spirit**⁽⁵⁾; to another the gifts of healing⁽⁶⁾ by the same Spirit;
- ❖ **Corinthians1 12:10** **To another** the working of miracles; to **another** prophecy; to **another** discerning of spirits; to another divers **kinds of tongues**; to **another** the interpretation of tongues:⁽⁷⁾

False Doctrines

Jesus told that people teach false doctrines.

- ❖ **Matthew 15:9** (But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men).
- ❖ **Mark 7:8** (For you set aside the **commandment of God**, and hold tightly to the tradition of men.)

Hypocrisy must be rejected:

- ❖ **Matthew 15:8** (This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their **heart is far from me.**)

If anyone reads the whole Bible of 66 and 73 won't find that Jesus said "I am God" or "Worship me".

The concept or assumption of "Trinity" came later on, after Jesus. Christ Jesus did not preach Trinity at all.

Jesus is a teacher. He is not God.

- ❖ **Matthew 23:8** (But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your **Master**, even Christ; and all ye are brethren).

The True God is one and he is in heaven.

- ❖ **Matthew 23:9** (And call no man your father upon the earth: **for one is your Father, which is in heaven.**)

Jesus asked God for help. So, he is not God to be served.

- ❖ **Matthew 27:46** (And about the ninth hour Jesus **cried with a loud voice**, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, **My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?**)

Jesus is approved by miracles

Jesus is a man approved by miracles to accept preaching Gospel.

- ❖ **Act 2:22** (Ye men of Israel, hear these words; **Jesus** of Nazareth, **a man approved** by God among you by **miracles** and **wonders** and **signs**, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know)
- ❖ **Act 4:30 (World English Bible)** (while you stretch out your hand to heal; and that **signs** and **wonders** may be done through the name of your holy Servant Jesus.”)
- ❖ **Matthew 9:35** (And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing** every **sickness** and every **disease** among the people.)
- ❖ **Matthew 10:8** (Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.)

In Islam, Allah (the True God) supports his messengers with signs and miracles to believe in them such as a stick changed to a snake for Moses. Jesus spoke in the cradle and healed people ...etc. Fire didn't burn Abraham.

Quran 5:110 (Remember) when Allah will say (on the Day of Resurrection). “O ‘Iesa (Jesus), son of Maryam (Mary)! Remember My Favour to you and to your mother when I **supported** you with Holy Spirit; [Jibrael (Gabriel)] so that you **spoke** to the people in the **cradle** and in maturity; and when I **taught you writing**, Al-Hikmah (the power of understanding), the Taurat (Torah) and the Injeel (Gospel); and when you made out of the **clay**, as it were, the figure of a **bird**, by My Permission, and you breathed into it, and it became a bird by My Permission, and you **healed** those born **blind**, and the **lepers** by

My Permission, and when you brought forth the **dead** by My Permission;

The true God

- ❖ **John 17:3** (And this is life eternal, that they might know thee **the only true God**, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.)
- ❖ **Luke 18:18** (And a certain ruler asked him, saying, Good Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?)
- ❖ **Luke 18:19** (And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? **none is good, save one, that is, God.**)
- ❖ **Mark 10:17** (And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?.)
- ❖ **Mark 10:18** (And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is **none good but one**, that is, **God.**)
- ❖ **Matthew 19:16** (And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?)
- ❖ **Matthew 19:17**(And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is **none good but one**, that is, **God**: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.)
- ❖ **John 20:17** (Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; **and to my God, and your God.**)

There is only one true God.

- ❖ **Isaiah 44:6** (I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.)
- ❖ **Isaiah 45:21** (and there is no God else beside me.)

- ❖ **Isaiah 45:22** (for I am God, and there is none else).
- ❖ **Isaiah 45:23** (That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear).

All prophets prayed to God.

- ❖ **Genesis 17:3** (And Abram ‘’Abraham’’ **fell on his face**: and God talked with him.)
- ❖ **Jonah 2:1** (Then Jonah **prayed** unto the LORD his God out of the fish’s belly).
- ❖ **Matthew 26:39**(And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and **prayed**).
- ❖ **Mark 14:32** (And he saith to his disciples, Sit ye here, while I shall **pray**.)
- ❖ **Mark 14:35** (And he went forward a little, and fell on the ground, and **prayed**.)
- ❖ **Luke 6:12**(And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to **pray**, and continued all night in **prayer** to God.)
- ❖ **Luke 22:41**(And he was withdrawn from them about a stone’s cast, and kneeled down, and **prayed**).

Previous Revelations stated that a prophet would come later on.

In **Matthew 21:42** (Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The **stone** which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is **marvellous** in our eyes?)

In **Psalms 118:22**(The **stone** which the builders refused is become the **head stone of the corner.**)

in **Psalms 118:23** (This is the LORD's doing; it is **marvellous** inoureyes.)⁽⁸⁾

In **Matthew 21:44** (And whosoever shall fall on **this stone** shall be broken: but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.)

Jesus said to them, the kingdom of God will be given to another nation to do the will of God:

❖ **John 4:34** (Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.)

❖ **Matthew 21:43** (Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and **given to a nation** bringing forth the fruits thereof.)

Prophet Muhammed (PBUH) died at age of 63 after he had completed his mission.

(This day, I have perfected your religion for you, completed My Favor upon you, and have chosen for you Islam as your religion.) Quran5:3

8 In **Islamic quoting**: Prophet Muhammed PBUH said “The parable of myself and the Prophets before me is a like a person who constructed a house quite imposing and beautiful, but for **one brick in one of its corners**. People would go round it, marvel the building, but saying: Why has the **brick** not been fixed here? He said: **I am that brick and I am the last of the prophets”**.

Jesus honors and respects prophet Muhammed.

❖ **Matthew 3:11**(I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me **is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear:** he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire.)

Prophet Muhammed (PBUH) is prophesied in the book of Isaiah 29:12

(And the book is delivered to him that is **not learned**, saying, **Read this**, I pray thee: and he saith, **I am not learned.**)

Muhammed (PBUH) was raised illiterate.

While he (PBUH) was in the cave of Hira, the angel Gabriel came to him in that cave. The Holy Spirit (Gabriel) commanded Muhammed (PBUH) to read. He replied, ‘I do not know how to read’ (three times).

Jesus didn't bring any new law. His mission was to fulfil the law of Moses.

Matthew 5:17(Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, **but to fulfil.**)

Matthew 5:18 (For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, **till all be fulfilled.**)

Muhammed will testify of Jesus.

John 15:26 (But when the **Comforter** is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, **he shall testify of me**)

Jesus is telling the truth :

❖ **John 16:7**(Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that **I go away**: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send **him** unto you).

We do not know exactly the original Aramaic word used by Jesus Christ for **Comforter**. Other Bible used **Consoler, Advocate, Helper**, and in **Greek Bibles** used the word **Paraclete**. There are different explanations for that. Some say, it might refer to the **Holy Spirit, or to the Word, or to a person.....etc.**

[**John.16:5**] [But now I go my way to him that sent me; and none of you asketh me, Whither goest thou?]

[**John.16:6**] [But because I have said these things unto you, sorrow hath filled your heart.]

[**John.16:7**][Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the **Comforter** will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send **him** unto you.]

[**John.16:8**] [And when **he** is come, **he** will **reprove** the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment.]

[**John.16:9**] [Of sin, because they believe not on me;]

[**John.16:10**] [Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;]

[**John.16:11**] [Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.]

[**John.16:12**] [I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.]

[**John.16:13**] [Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth⁽⁹⁾, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.]

[**John.16:14**] [He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.]

9 Muhammed (PBUH)

Consequently, Jesus is informing his disciples that he is about to leave the world, that he has not fulfilled his mission, but that another will come after him to teach the truth explicitly.

To summaries the previous verses of John 16:5-14. Jesus reported that:

- ✓ He would go away.
- ✓ Someone would come after him.
- ✓ Someone would guide humans to the truth.
- ✓ Someone would not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears, he will speak.
- ✓ Someone would glorify Christ Jesus.
- ✓ Someone would prophesy.

The Holy Qur'an states that Jesus explicitly mentioned the name Ahmad which meant be Muhammed: "And, remember when Iesa (Jesus), son of Maryam (Mary), said to the Israelites I am the Messenger of Allah unto you confirming the Taurat [(Torah) which came] before me, and giving glad tidings of a Messenger who will come after me, whose name shall be Ahmed. But when he (Ahmed i.e. Muhammad PBUH) came to them with clear proofs, (to support his truthfulness), they said: "This is plain magic." Quran 61:6

The prophecy clearly stated that (if Jesus departs, the Comforter will come).

The Bible declares that the Holy Spirit was **already present** on earth before and during the time of Jesus. So, the word (Comforter) doesn't refer to the Holy Spirit.

And Jesus used the pronoun (HIM) "I will send **him** unto you". (HIM) refers to **human beings**. He might use pronoun (**IT**) to refer to an object such as (Holy Spirit).

Hence this prophecy refers to none other than Prophet Muhammad (pbuh).

In the Bible of John, 15:26, and 16:7, the word “**Comforter**” is used in the English translation for the Greek word Paracletos or Pericyltos or Paraclete which means advocate or a kind of a friend. **Paracletos** means the one who is described for lots of praise or (the praised one). In Arabic, the word “**Ahmed** and **Muhammed**” means “ the praise one or who has lots of praise.

That is to say the prophet **Muhammed (PBUH)**.

The coming prophet will speak what he hears.

- ❖ **John 16:12** (I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now).
- ❖ **John 16:13** (Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.)

Prophet Muhammed used to be called trustworthy by the disbelievers themselves in Makkah.

- ❖ **Revelation 19:11**(And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.)

Moses....Jesus....Muhammed

❖ **Deuteronomy 33:2** (And he said, The LORD came from **Sinai**, and rose up from **Seir** unto them; he shined forth from mount **Paran**⁽¹⁰⁾, and he came with ten thousands⁽¹¹⁾ of saints: from his right hand went a fiery law for them).

(**Sinai**) indicates the revelation place of **Moses**.

(**Seir**) indicates the revelation place of **Jesus**.

(**Paran**) indicates the revelation place of **Muhammed**.

In Holy Ouran, chapter 95

Verse.1 (**By the fig, and the olive,**) the place of **Jesus**.

Verse.2 (**By Mount Sinai,**) the place of **Moses**.

Verse.3 (**And by this city of security (Makkah)**, the place of **Muhammed**.

❖ **Habakkuk 3:3** (God came from Teman⁽¹²⁾, and the Holy One from **mount Paran**. Selah. His glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of his praise.)

Moses truly told about a prophet that God will send:

Acts3:22 (For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your **brethren(Arab)**, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.)

10 *Paran or Pharan* is a chain of mountains in Makkah.

11 Prophet Muhammed [pbuh] went with **ten thousands of soldiers** to recapture Makkah on the 10th of Ramadan, 8 A.H. that is in 630 AD

12 It is 200 miles north of Medina in Saudia Arabia where the descendants of Ishmael's son Tema dwelt.

Moses instructs people to accept that prophet:

- ❖ **Acts 3:23** (And it shall come to pass, that **every soul, which will not hear** that prophet, shall be **destroyed** from among the people).

The Law will be abrogated.

- ❖ **Ezekiel 21:25** (And thou, profane wicked prince of Israel, whose day is come, when iniquity shall have an end,)
- ❖ **Ezekiel 21:26** (Thus saith the Lord GOD; Remove the diadem⁽¹³⁾, and take off the crown: this shall not be the same: exalt him that is low, and abase him that is high.)
- ❖ **Ezekiel 21:27** (I will overturn, overturn, overturn, it: and it shall be no more, until **he** come whose right it is; and I will give it **him**⁽¹⁴⁾.)
- ❖ **Deuteronomy 18:18** (I will raise them up a Prophet from among their **brethren(Arab)**, like unto thee(**Moses**), and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him).

13 It indicates that the Israelites law will be taken.

14 That might be Muhammed.

❖ **Analysis:**

Abraham (pbuh) has two sons: Ishmael and Isaac (pbuh).

Jews are the descendants of **Isaac** (pbuh).

Arabs are the descendants of **Ishmael** (pbuh).

So, **Arabs** and **Jews** are brethren.

Similarities between Muhammed and Moses

- Both had natural birth.
- Both had a father and a mother.
- Both were married and had children.
- Both became prophets at age of 40.
- Both were rejected first and then accepted as prophets.
- Both were leaders of their people.
- Both were followed by the poor but later also by their enemies.
- Both brought many people out of idolatry.
- Both spoke about the “God of Abraham” firmly.
- Both brought new laws and new legislations.
- Both were shepherds.
- Both passed away by natural death.
- Both were exiled from their homes.
- Both were widely accepted during their lives.

Pilgrimages pass the valley of Baca (Makkah) and they fill the pools with water.

- ❖ **Psalm 84:5** (Blessed is the man whose strength is in thee; in whose heart are the ways of them).
- ❖ **Psalm 84:6** (Who passing through the valley of **Baca** make it a well; the rain also **filleth the pools.**)⁽¹⁵⁾

Ishmael's Offspring will multiply exceedingly.

- ❖ **Geniuses 17:20** (And as **for Ishmael**, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him **fruitful**, and will **multiply him exceedingly.**)

God will make a nation from Ishmael's seed:

- ❖ **Geniuses 21:13** (And also of the son of the bondwoman will **I make a nation**, because he is **thy seed.**)

His nation will be great:

- ❖ **Geniuses 21:18** (Arise, lift up the lad ⁽¹⁶⁾, and hold him in thine hand; for I will make him **a great nation.**)

The Story of Hagar (the mother of Ishmael) in Paran (place where Makkah locates):

- ❖ **Geniuses 21:16**)And she went, and sat her down over against him a good way off, as it were a bow shot: for she said, Let me not see the death of the child. And she sat over against him, and lift up her voice, and wept.)
- ❖ **Geniuses 21:17** (And God heard the voice of the **lad**; and the angel of God called to Hagar out of heaven, and said unto her, What aileth thee, Hagar? fear not; for God hath heard the voice of the **lad** where he is.)
- ❖ **Geniuses 21:19** (And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water⁽¹⁷⁾; and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the **lad** drink.)
- ❖ **Geniuses 21:20** (And God was with the **lad**; and he grew, and dwelt in the wilderness, and became an archer.)
- ❖ **Geniuses 21:21** (And he dwelt in the wilderness of **Paran**: and his mother took him a wife out of the land of Egypt.)

One more thing.

Christians tradition ceremonies are not from Jesus teachings at all. If Jesus is here, he wouldn't accept such as procedures of having ceremonies through what so-called "Eucharist, (The Lord Supper), Communion and Mass". Claiming that Jesus reported (drinking represents his blood and eating bread represents his body). You can read that in Matthew 26:26-29, Mark 14:22-25 and in Luke 22:17-19. That was added to the Bible by Paul when he sent his own letter to Corinthians.

Islam is the religion of all prophets. It is universal. Revelation had been sent down to all previous prophets.

Prophet Muhammed (PBUH) used to recite these two following verses in the two rak'ahs of sunnat al Fajr :

Quran 2:136 (Say (O Muslims), "We believe in Allah and that which has been sent down to us and that which has been sent down to Ibrahim (Abraham), Isma'il (Ishmael), Ishaque (Isaac), Ya'qub (Jacob), and to Al-Asbat [the twelve sons of Ya'qub (Jacob)], and that which has been given to Musa (Moses) and 'Iesa (Jesus), and that which has been given to the Prophets from their Lord. We make no distinction between any of them, and to Him we have submitted (in Islam).")

Quran 3:64 (Say (O Muhammad SAW): "O people of the Scripture (Jews and Christians): Come to a term that is just between us and you, that we worship none but Allah, and that we associate no partners with Him, and that none of us shall take others as lords besides Allah. Then, if they turn away, say: "Bear witness that we are Muslims.")

Paraclete Here is an authentic story.

Enslam Tormida was born in 1355 AD in Spain. He was a Christian. When he reached the age of six, his father handed him over to a priest to teach him the Bible. He could memorize more than half of the Bible within 2 years. He finished studying the Biblical language and the logic science in 6 years. When he was fourteen, he traveled from his own town to another one. There, he studied herbal medicine sciences and stars, "Astrology" in 6 years. At age of 20 he began to teach the Bible and its language for 4 years.

At age of 24 he moved to another city. It was a large city of knowledge. There was a church for an elderly priest named (Naqlaw Martil) who was very high in status of knowledge and religion. He served the priest and carried out many of his jobs until he became one of his best characteristics. The priest trusted him and gave him the keys of his own house and the food supply store key. He studied the Bible well and serve the priest for 10 years. He became 34 years old.

One day, the priest " Naqlaw Martil " was absent from his lesson because he was sick. The students waited for him while they were discussing matters in the Bible until they came across a phrase that Jesus stated "a prophet will come after him named "Paraclete ". So, they searched to figure out who that prophet would be. Then the priest (Naqlaw Martil) asked him "What did you have today of searching?" when I was absent? He told him that the students differed about the name of "Paraclete". One said it might be so-and-so. Another said it might be- such- and-such. Another answered so-and-so. The boy listed their answers and showed them to the priest. He said all the answers were wrong. Because the interpretation of this honorable name was known by well-educated scholars only. Consequently, the boy rushed to kiss his feet and said to him: Oh, my dear, you knew that I traveled and came to you from faraway. I had ten years in your service

that I had acquired much knowledge from you. I would like to know this beautiful honorable name. The priest cried and said: O my son, if you declare that, Christians may kill you. “My son, I asked you first when you arrived about your country and whether it is close to Muslims, in order to test your anti-Islam attitude. Listen my son, that Paraclete is one of the names of their Prophet Muhammad. The fourth book revealed upon him which was mentioned by Daniel. He told that his religion was the religion of truth and it was the white religion mentioned in the Bible.

He said: Sir, “what do you say about the religion of Christians?” He said: My son, if the Christians were based on the first religion of Jesus, they would have followed the religion of God. Jesus and all the prophets have the same religion of God. He asked: Sir, “how can we get rid of this matter?” He answered him saying: Oh, my son, I recommend you to enter the religion of God “Islam”.
